- Kandoolu now has Grammar assessments and resources! In a first step towards incorporating ELA, we've released our grammar content. All content was written and managed by the Allegheny Intermediate Unit's Reading Achievement Center. Try it out and let us know what you think, reading content is not far behind!
- Quiz sharing is here! One of our top requests was to allow teachers to share out quizzes that they've made with others. Teachers can now do just that. You can also access others' quizzes when you explore Global Quizzes (located in the left side menu).
- Additional in-progress quiz stats! When teachers are giving a self-guided quiz, they will now see an average class score as well as the class' weakest question.
- Additional stats in the "Class View" for teacher led quizzes as well! When giving a teacher led quiz and sharing the Class View, you can now lock down answers to see a small graph that displays how many students chose each distractor and how many got the question right!
- Revamp of Google and Schoology integration. We've streamlined things and made it much easier to link your Google/Schoology accounts to Kandoolu. We've also given teachers more power when it comes to deciding which groups to sync to their roster.
- Pending Roster Page. We heard teachers say that they didn't like the all or nothing approach when it came to importing student rosters. We now allow teachers to view a list of student accounts that are pending, so they can choose who to approve for account creation and addition onto their roster.
- There is now a scratchpad for teachers! We couldn't let students have all of the fun so we've enabled a scratch pad for teachers as well. Use it to work problems out in front of the class or show off your doodling skills.
- New password font! If you've been tricked by the letter l vs. the number 1 in Kandoolu, you're not alone. We made sure that now the number one in passwords truly looks like a number 1 so there's no confusion.
- Standard Coverage Report- this feature actually came out last release, but it seems like it's underutilized. Check it out if you haven't yet! New this release is the fact that you can now export this report to a csv.
